



Top Texas Family Businesses Honored

WACO, Texas – Baylor University’s Institute for Family Business will be honoring the 2013 Texas Family Business of the Year award winners and finalists at an awards banquet to be held on Monday, Nov. 4 at Baylor University’s Bill Daniel Student Center.

The Texas Family Business of the Year awards program recognizes **outstanding firms whose families demonstrate a commitment to each other and to business continuity, and who are responsive to the needs of their employees, communities and industries.**

This year, well over 200 companies entered into the awards program process. Twenty-four family business applications, from across the state of Texas, were in the final wave of judging.
